In 2014, he was instrumental in the development of a first of its kind post-surgical spine rehabilitation certificate program in partnership with the American Chiropractic Association. This course was designed to educate chiropractors and other healthcare providers in the multidisciplinary and evidence-based delivery of perioperative care for patients with debilitating spine conditions.

Dr. Gross has also received additional training and credentials in MRI of the spine through the University at Buffalo Jacobs School of Medicine & Biomedical Sciences, is a

Certified Chiropractic Sports Physician (CCSP) and is also a Fellow of the International Academy of Medical Acupuncture (FIAMA).
